To bring together the children, young people and families of our Parish for fun and faith events, forming positive relationships.

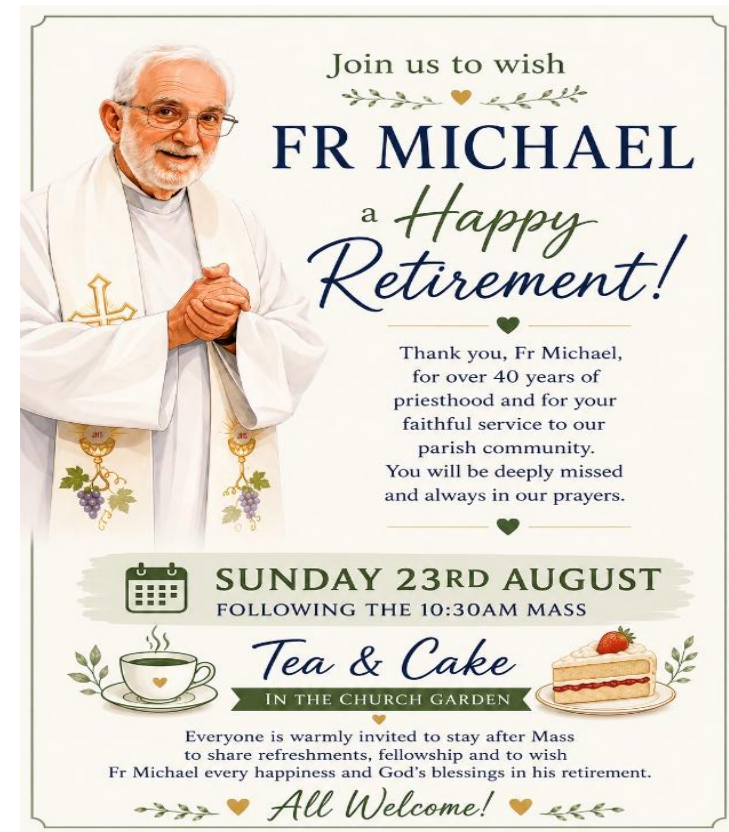
