Abuse can take many forms, domestic, physical, emotional, bullying, sexual, neglect and self neglect. Any concerns report them to your safeguarding representative.

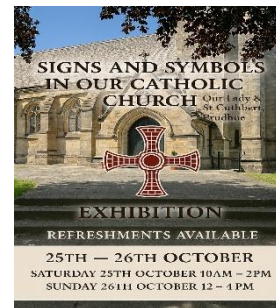
