From Bishop Robert: On Tuesday 10 November 2020 at midday, the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (IICSA) published its investigation into the Catholic Church of England and Wales. Dioceses have been advised that all media enquiries will be handled centrally by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW). I would ask that we keep all victims of abuse in our prayers and ask God's forgiveness for these terrible crimes. A new statement of the Bishop's Conference is attached to our website.

Michael. If the parishioner is in hospital or a care home, permission must be obtained from the nurse in charge before contacting a priest. **Any visits can only be made in an emergency at this time.**
