Christmas Season. Friday 10th January. Readings: 1 John 5:5-13; Psalm: 147; Gospel: Luke 5:12-16.

Today's story centres, for us, on the healing of disease. This is totally understandable, as this is about making whole the person who is ill and wounded. For the time, however, being clean meant much more than physical healing. It meant being acceptable in society. Being healed needed immediate acknowledgement by the authorities, the priest. This man would now be able to enter society as a whole person. Once again Jesus lines up with the Old Testament prophets.
