From the Mass of the Lord's Supper, by an ancient tradition, the Church does not celebrate the Sacraments at all, except for the sick. On Good Friday there is no Mass, but Communion is shared at the Liturgy of the Passion. For these days the Church enters the tomb with Christ and awaits the Resurrection. On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the Lord's tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on his Passion and Death and on his Descent into Hell and awaiting his Resurrection. On this day, only the Mass of the Easter Vigil is allowed to be celebrated.
